The **Mission** of The Hagar House is to free **single mothers** from cycles of crisis through a Christ-centered community.

Our **Vision** is to empower single mothers → transforming generations.

Our **Goals**- Actively develop strong, healthy, self-sufficient moms and children, as a family unit. We will focus on job skills, education, whole health habits, and spiritual aspects of life.

- While living at The Hagar House:
 - Residents will be honest and transparent with the staff of The Hagar House
 - Measurable goals will be set and actively worked toward
 - All families will be responsible for household chores
 - Daily meal preparation and clean-up
 - Curfew will be Weekdays- 8:00 pm for kids on school nights/10:00 for moms.
Weekends-10:00 pm for everyone, unless working a late shift.
 - There will be an admittance drug test and random drug tests throughout a resident's stay.
NO TOLERANCE - Drug and/or Alcohol usage
 - Able to administer own Meds, with the potential to be overseen by staff.
 - While working, 30% of your income will automatically be withdrawn from each paycheck (25% deposited into a separate savings account held for you and 5% going to THH Program Fees).

STEP 3 – If accepted, arrange a move-in day (process details at the interview).
