The **Mission** of The Hagar House is to free single mothers from cycles of crisis through a Christ-centered community.

Our **Vision** is to empower single mothers → transforming generations.

Our **Goals**- Actively develop strong, healthy, self-sufficient moms and children, as a family unit. We will focus on job skills, education, whole health habits and spiritual aspects of life.

- While living at The Hagar House:
 - Measurable goals will be set and actively worked toward
 - All families will be responsible for household chores
 - Weekly meal planning/preparation and clean-up
 - Curfew will be Weekdays- 8:00 pm for kids on school nights/10:00 for moms.
Weekends-10:00 pm for everyone, unless working a late shift.
 - There will be an admittance drug test and random drug tests throughout a resident's stay. NO TOLERANCE - Drug and/or Alcohol usage
 - Able to administer own Meds, with the potential to be overseen by staff.
 - The Hagar House can dismiss you at anytime for any reason deemed necessary by both the Executive Director and Program Director.
 - While working, 30% of your income will automatically be withdrawn from each paycheck (25% deposited into a separate savings account held for you and 5% going to THH Program Fees).

STEP 1 - please complete the Resident Application and return it to The Hagar House at info@thehagarhouse.org or 915 North 5th Street, Wausau, WI 54403.

- We will also need the following things from you at that time:
 - Copy of your driver's license
 - Copy of your social security card and/or birth certificate

STEP 2 - Once all required paperwork is in, we will contact you for an in-person interview if we are able to move forward. We will further assess your situation and determine if we are a good fit for each other.

STEP 3 – Arrange move in day (process details at interview).
